

# The WOLF CHIP STAND



A corn snack taking on the form of a cone is a staple snack in the Wolf office. Light, and crunchy, anyone that's entered the Wolf premises, whether it be client, employee or friend, would have been offered a taste. Being originally served in a bowl, something so delicate and intriguing in form deserved more of a stage to be presented on.

It was here that Taras conceived the idea of the chip stand. Each cone standing as itself - alone and showcased as a piece of art.

The chip stand started from a raw pine block, which went through the process of being cut down, sanded, stained and polished to form the base. Brass rods were then drilled into it, standing vertically to suspend the chips, one per rod. The project was worked on by the entire Wolf pack and the stand is now used on a frequent basis to greet all clients along with a cup of tea.
